Advisory Memorandum
December 12, 2006

Re: Health Profession Corporations

On July 20th 2006, upon the order of the Province of British Columbia Lieutenant Governor in Council, the bylaws of the College of Naturopathic Physicians of British Columbia were approved and ordered. Following this order, the Lieutenant Governor in Council amended the Naturopathic Physicians Regulations by adding Part 4 of the Health Professions Act applied to Naturopathic medicine. This means that all ND's corporation must be registered with the College and meet certain parameters, namely Part 4 of the HP Act and Part 7 of the College Bylaws.

The registration process is an annual, calendar cycle, and in order to accommodate existing corporations' timelines, CNPBC Registration Committee is introducing the first cycle ending December 31st, 2007. During this first cycle, existing corporations will be given the opportunity to amend their corporation constitution at their next annual general meeting to the requirements of the HP Act and its Bylaws.

Please visit the CNPBC web site for more details and forms. We recommend that the application be made at the earliest, so that necessary adjustments can be made at the next renewal time of your corporation.
